

Banting Institute Availability

Overview

The Banting Institute was built on its current site in 1930 to recognize Frederick Banting's part in the discovery of insulin in a nearby University of Toronto building nine years prior.

The Banting Institute was once one of two buildings that were home to the University of Toronto's Banting and Best Department of Medical Research until 2005. Now the building is home to more than fifty startups alongside other commercialization partner tenants that occupy all 5 floors of the building.
